**\$71
MILLION**

Landowners along the 163-mile route have been paid more than \$71 million for easements and the loss of crops. Easement payments are based on fair market value and crop loss payments are based on the type of crop and proven crop rotation. For example, sugar cane farmers can be compensated for a total of five years; 100% the 1st year, 60% the 2nd year, then 45%, 30%, and 25% for years 3 through 5.

**\$420
MILLION**

The project will generate over \$420 million in wages through an estimated 2,500 well-paying construction jobs that support families and stimulate spending in our local communities.

**\$34.5
MILLION**

Through our commitment to purchase goods and services locally, more than \$34 million has been spent on steel, civil survey and engineering design services, construction and the majority of equipment and labor.

**\$77
THOUSAND**

This project will add an additional 12 full-time jobs to our local employee base, bringing our total number of employees in Louisiana to more than 600, with an annual salary average of \$77,000.
